Fitting contest Rules:

- 1. Each participant is responsible for one of their own does or wethers. Goats can be boer or dairy.
- 2. All equipment and supplies must be in place prior to the starting time of the contest.
- 3. Each individual must provide their own fitting equipment. The contest will take place in the show arena. Once the contest begins, no participant m;ay leave the show ring area and no additional equipment may be brought into the fitting area.

- 4. Teams of two will compete. One participant must be a goat exhibitor.
- 5. Contestants have 30 mins to complete their work.
- 6. All goats are to be pre-washed prior to the contest starting.
- Stand will be provided if you do not have one, but must be requested during the meeting prior to the contest starting.
